## Improved economic reports and overall writing for a global team of non-native writers

#### **CHALLENGES**

The International Trade Administration supports U.S. exports and economic interests in seven countries, including Thailand, Malaysia, and Myanmar. Due diligence documents and other reports lacked in content and syntax, requiring multiple rounds of rewrites. Officers were wasting time editing documents, cutting into their client-facing hours.

### **SOLUTIONS**

Some ITA participants needed support to improve fundamental English business writing skills. Others needed focused instruction and guidance to elevate complex 100-page reports. We customized two courses based on these goals. Each participant received individual feedback on their writing. The self-paced courses allowed each learner to work at a pace and on a schedule that best suited their learning style. After the training, we shared resources with senior leaders that will support the ongoing mentorship of employee writing.

## **OUTCOMES**



#### Reduce writing time by over 20%

**The International Trade Administration will save an estimated \$468,750** assuming 75 participants trained yearly, with an average salary of \$50k, and who write four hours per day.



#### Individual improvement at every level

Self-paced, online courses allowed participants to **outline their goals** and challenges, resulting in extremely individualized feedback from the instructor. Every participant from ITA improved their writing.
